NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT ORDINANCE

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Supervisors will introduce Ordinance No. 2019-13 for public review and comment at its meeting on Wednesday, July 3, 2019, at 7:00 P.M. at the Township office located at 565 Chicora Road, Butler, PA. If no substantial changes are made, the Supervisors will consider adoption of the proposed Ordinance immediately following the public comment period.

The proposed Ordinance is titled “An Ordinance Governing On-Lot Sewage Disposal Facilities; Requiring Sewage Facility Planning; Regulating Design, Construction, Operation, Maintenance, Alteration, Repair and Replacement of Such Facilities; Requiring Replacement Areas, Ground Markers, Access Hatches and Inspection Ports; Authorizing Administration and Inspection Fees; Providing Exemptions, Appeal and Enforcement Procedures, and Penalties for Violations.”

In summary, the 31-page proposed Ordinance provides comprehensive regulations for the design, construction, operation, maintenance, alteration, repair, and replacement of on-lot sewage disposal facilities within the Township. The proposed Ordinance includes the following sections:

- §15-17: Preemption.
- §15-118: Severability.
- §15-119: Repealer.
- §15-120: Effective Date.
